### **Clerk's report**

Clerk Myrick noted the November 3<sup>rd</sup> general election went well. There was a total of 592 registered voters that voted in Sherman Township. Clerk Myrick also noted that the Sherman Township Cemetery has been cleaned of debris, and trash cans have been emptied. Clerk Myrick shared with the board that a permit was received from the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes & Energy to install five new culverts along M-18 in Sage and Sherman Townships. Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to accept the clerk's report as presented. Seconded by Treasurer Jurgensen. *M/C*

### **Treasurer's report and financial report**

Treasurer Jurgensen noted that she received the State of MI Constitutional Sales Tax for July and August 2020 in the amount of \$18,336.00. Treasurer Jurgensen noted Gladwin Community Schools summer tax collection has been received in the amount of \$1729.80. Treasurer Jurgensen also noted that the winter tax bill will go out December 1, 2020. Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. ### **Assessor's Report**

Assessor Cuddie has completed 20% of parcel checks in Sherman Township. Assessor Cuddie presented the "Gladwin County Interlocal Agreement for County Designated Assessor" in case a township fails the AMR twice then the designated assessor for Gladwin County would take over the tax roll for the township. The appointment must be approved by means of an inter-local agreement between the County Board of Commissioners and a majority of the local units within the county. Supervisor Jurgensen made motion to accept the "Gladwin County Interlocal Agreement for County Designated Assessor" as presented and to sign the agreement. Seconded by Clerk Myrick. M/C

### **Old Business**

Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to revise the "Sherman Township Mowing Agreement" for FY 2021 by increasing payment for mowing and trimming four times a year at the Sherman Township Cemetery to \$140. Seconded by Clerk Myrick. M/C
