Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:30 pm by Supervisor John Jurgensen.

Clerk's report

Treasurer's report and financial report

Treasurer Jurgensen collected a total of \$1,341,379.04 in summer and winter taxes. Treasurer Jurgensen noted that the admin fees that were on prior hold for Gladwin School District deficit = Board of Review that was collected from December 16-31, 2020 were deposited into the Admin Fees account.

Treasurer Jurgensen presented the board with the Gladwin Community Schools Tax Collection Agreement in which the Sherman Township Treasurer will collect the 2021 summer taxes and receive \$3.10 per parcel per year. Treasurer Jurgensen made a motion to accept the Tax Collection Agreement with Gladwin Community Schools for 2021. Seconded by Supervisor Jurgensen. M/C
