

Sherman Township Regular Meeting 07-20-21

Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:30 pm by Supervisor John Jurgensen.

Public Comments

Commissioner Grove indicated due to several areas of Gypsy Moth damage in the Gladwin County area there will be a county wide proposal brought to the voters at the November 2, 2021, election. Commissioner Grove noted that at the end of July 31, 2021, Laura Brandon-Mavel will be resigning as the Interim County Administrator.

Minutes

Minutes were presented from the regular board meeting held on June 15, 2021. Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to approve the minutes as amended. Seconded by Trustee Grabowski. M/C

Minutes were presented from the special meeting held concerning the Gladwin County Equalization/GIS Department Contract for 2021-2022 held on June 22, 2021. Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting held on June 22, 2021. Seconded by Trustee Paisley. M/C

Minutes were presented from the special meeting held on July 9, 2021 concerning Sherman Township Resolution 2021-04, to deem that Sherman Township of Gladwin County, Michigan is a governmental entity with elected officials to do the business of the Township. Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting held on July 9, 2021. Seconded by Trustee Paisley. M/C

Warrants

Warrants were presented. Treasurer Jurgensen made a motion to accept the warrants as presented, but also pay the additional warrant for DeLisle Lawn Care in the amount of \$18,580.00. Seconded by Trustee Grabowski. M/C

Clerk's report

Clerk Myrick noted concerning the complaint at 5000 Renas Road, that a letter was received from Dennis Cantrell, Sanitarian from the Gladwin Branch of the Central Michigan District Health Department. Mr. Cantrell noted that one of the camping trailers has been removed from the premises. Mr. Cantrell also indicated that all grey water and sewage is being properly disposed of in a holding tank that is churns the waste and sent it to the septic system. Mr. Cantrell indicated to the residents that there cannot be more than four camping trailers at one residence and a camping

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permit is required from the DNR each time someone stays in one of the campers. Treasurer Jurgensen made a motion to accept the clerk's report as presented. Seconded by Trustee Grabowski. M/C

Treasurer's report and financial report

Treasurer Jurgensen stated that the summer tax payments have started coming in regularly. Treasurer Jurgensen noted she received the Local Community Stabilization - Metro Funds in the amount of \$2605.09. On July 20, 2021, Treasurer Jurgenson submitted the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 the Federal Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (CLFRF) for the estimated amount of \$107,495. Sherman Township will have until 2024 to utilize the funds as allowed by the federal government. Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as presented. Seconded by Grabowski. M/C

Trustees Report

Trustee Grabowski gave an update for the Gladwin Rural Urban Fire Protection District. Trustee Paisley noted that there will be a hall rental on July 24, 2021. Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to accept the trustee's report as presented. Seconded by Clerk Myrick. M/C

Supervisor's Report

Supervisor Jurgensen noted that he is listed as the Point of Contact with the Red Cross. Supervisor Jurgensen indicated that the road project is completed in Grass Lake and looks very good. Supervisor Jurgensen stated he did not receive a blight report from Bill Whitten for the month of July.

Supervisor Jurgensen noted the final brining will be done on July 27, 21. Residents on Sargent Rd do not want their road brined so there will be three passes made on a one mile stretch of Sugar River Road. Clerk Myrick made a motion to accept the supervisors report as presented. Seconded by Treasurer Jurgensen. M/C

Assessor's Report

Assessor Cuddie mentioned that the next Board of Review will be held December 14, 2021 at 1:00 pm at the Sherman Township Hall. Assessor Cuddie noted parcel checks are complete on Dutcher Road and Corlew Road. Assessor Cuddie indicated she received a zoning complaint from 5318 Jewel Street in Grass Lake.
