Minutes

- Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM by Supervisor John Jurgensen.
- Board members present: Supervisor John Jurgensen, Treasurer Jean Jurgensen, Clerk Kay Whalen, Trustee Ron Grabowski, & Trustee Sarah Paisley.

- Special Guest: Kyle Grove, County Commissioner, advised 2 new cruisers for the police department have been ordered and should be in commission by early summer.

Minutes

- Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to approve the minutes from the Special Board Meeting of 1/11/22 and it was supported by Trustee Ron Grabowski. M/C
- Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to approve the Regular Board Meeting minutes of 1/18/22. Clerk, Kay Whalen moved to accept and Trustee, Sarah Paisley seconded. M/C
- Supervisor Jurgensen made the motion to approve the minutes of second Special Board meeting of 1/18/22. Treasurer, Jean Jurgensen moved to accept and it was seconded by Clerk, Whalen.
- Lastly, Supervisor Jurgensen made a motion to approve the minutes of the Special Board Meeting of 1/27/22. Trustee, Ron Grabowski moved to accept the minutes and Trustee, Sarah Paisley seconded. M/C

Warrants

-Warrants were presented by Supervisor Jurgensen and a motion was made to accept the warrants and Trustee, Ron Grabowski supported the motion. M/C

Clerk's Report

Treasurer's Report

-Treasurer, Jean Jurgensen reported that the Township received and additional \$216.17 in redistributed ARPA funds.

-Treasurer, Jurgensen discussed moving funds to another financial source although she has been advised that Huntington's Municipal accounts now have a new manager. Treasurer, Jean Jurgensen made the motion that she have the ability to move ANY AND/OR ALL ACCOUNTS if problems continue and that the signees would remain: Jean Jurgensen, Treasurer; Kay Whalen, Clerk; and Veronica Vickers, Deputy Treasurer. Those accounts include: (1) General Fund, (2) Garbage Fund, (3) Grass Lake Rd. Fund, (4) Lake Lochbrae Weed Control Fund, (5) Lake Lochbrae Dam Inspection & Repair Fund, (6) Tax Account/Checking, and (7) Time Certificates of Deposit. The motion was seconded by Clerk, Kay Whalen. M/C

-Treasurer, Jean Jurgensen presented that SLFRF (STATE & LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS) required that 3 Key Roles had to be filled in order for the Township to be in a position to apply for funds available through SLFRF. Those in attendance were asked if anyone would be interested in filling a position and when no one volunteered, Clerk, Kay Whalen agreed to accept the position of the ACCOUNT ADMINISTRATOR and Treasurer Jean Jurgensen agreed to fill the last two positions; POINT OF CONTACT FOR REPORTING AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE FOR REPORTING. Supervisor, John Jurgensen made the motion to approve the appointments and Trustee, Ron Grabowski seconded the motion. M/C

Trustee's Report

-Trustee, Ron Grabowski presented the update for the Gladwin Rural Fire Protection District; including a report of the Fire Chief's duties.

-Trustee, Sarah Paisley reported that she has received a request from a resident for a July 10th hall rental. After checking the Township calendar, Supervisor John Jurgensen made the motion to accept the Trustee's Report and this was seconded by Treasurer Jurgensen. M/C

Supervisor's Report

- Supervisor John Jurgensen presented the final ARPA project proposal.
- Supervisor Jurgensen reported that due to a recent resignation, the Board of Review was in need of an alternate. He advised that the new member would be reimbursed for their training and would receive a salary. Supervisor John Jurgensen asked if anyone in attendance at the meeting had an interest in the position to contact him.
- Following Supervisor, John Jurgensen's report, Treasurer Jurgensen offered a more detailed report of the final ARPA proposal. There were questions from those in attendance and all were answered. County Commissioner, Kyle Grove, reported that businesses could also apply for ARPA funds (not just the Townships) and that a total of 29 applications had been received. Clerk, Kay Whalen made the motion to accept the Supervisor's Report and Treasurer, Jean Jurgensen seconded. M/C

Assessor's Report

- Assessor, Corey Cuddie reported that change notices from March 1st will be in effect for an entire year. Supervisor, John Jurgensen made a motion to accept the Assessor's Report and it was seconded by Treasurer, Jurgensen. M/XC

- Supervisor, John Jurgensen touched once more on the need for an alternate for the Board of Review.
- Supervisor Jurgensen discussed that a recent FEMA/Gladwin County Hazard Mitigation Advisory Committee had been formed and that someone from the board would need to be in attendance at each meeting in order for our Township to

qualify for FEMA funding as needed. Supervisor, John Jurgensen made the motion to adjourn and it was seconded by Clerk, Whalen. M/C
