A receipt will be sent only if a self-addressed stamped envelope is included with your payment. Check or money order is preferred. Cash payments must be exact amount. PARTIAL PAYMENTS ARE ACCEPTED. ► We do not accept credit or debit card payments. ■ Mail 2 weeks prior to due date.

**PLEASE NOTE: POSTMARK OR CHECK DATES ARE <u>NOT</u> ACCEPTED AS DATE OF PAYMENT. PAYMENTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE DEADLINE DATE TO AVOID INTEREST AND PENALTIES.

If summer taxes are paid <u>after September 14th</u> - <u>a 1% interest is added</u> from <u>Sept.15th to the 30th</u> and 1% each unpaid month thereafter beginning on the first day of each month.

Place glass or sharp objects in a secure container and clearly label contents to avoid injuries to those handling the trash.
