A receipt will be sent only if a self-addressed stamped envelope is included with your payment. Check or money order is preferred. Cash payments must be exact amount. **PARTIAL PAYMENTS ARE ACCEPTED.** ▶ We do not accept credit or debit card payments. ◀ Mail 2 weeks prior to due date.

If summer taxes are paid after September 16th -- a 1% interest is added from Sept.17th to the 30th and 1% each unpaid month thereafter beginning on the first day of each month.

When a holiday is on Monday, trash pick-up will be Tuesday.** If using an additional rolling type container, please limit the size to 35 gallons. Place glass or sharp objects in a secure container and clearly label contents to avoid injuries to those handling the trash.
